- What is the ideal number of students for a show? 100-150.
- Is there an extra charge for travelling costs? No, the price is final.
- Are the actors native speakers? Not only native speakers, but there will usually be one or two in the team.

#### Why theatre in English

- The language we learn in the classroom is often theoretical, while in real life, words are just part of a complicated live communication process. Theatre brings 'living' language to students in a way that normal classroom teaching can not.
- Live theatre creates genuine emotional reactions in the audience (as well as laughter). This motivates students to feel positive about learning the language. It also helps them learn specific elements of the language (grammar, phrases, etc.) in a memorable way.
- The shows are supported by teaching materials, which teachers can use before or after a show to link the theatre experience to their classroom teaching.
